Our leadership has met and discussed a process of beginning our worship services again physically. We have monitored, the overall situation and also evaluated our specific situation. While there is excitement and anticipation of opening back up, we wanted to share information on how our worship service will be conducted.

Rest assured that all areas have been cleaned and disinfected. We wanted everything to be clean before people entered the building.

We are going to begin by having an 11am service on Sunday, May 31st. We will also begin Wednesday night services beginning Wednesday, June 3rd at 6pm. For those not comfortable coming yet, we will still have online and DVD services available.

1. The worship service will look different for a few weeks. Here are a few things:

We are planning a "touchless" service. This is where we come in minimal or no contact with doors, pews, books, individuals, etc.

- -When you enter the parking lot, you will head toward the new sanctuary. This will be the only method of entry and exit. Door greeters will have the doors open so you do not have to come in contact with the door.
 - -Hand sanitizer will be available when you come in.
 - All announcements will be posted on the wall.
 - -We will recommend social distancing.
 - There will be no children's church or nursery.
 - All music and Bible verses will be on the wall.
 - The offering will be after the service and offering plates/boxes will be in the foyer as you exit.

As time goes by, we will revert back to more normal parts of services, extend services, and have fellowships again.

We have prayed for the day when the Lord will bring us back together. We are excited for this opportunity but we also need to be mindful. If you feel sick, or if your health may be in question about coming, please stay at home. We will have every available resource for you, and have everything ready when you can return.

I am eager to see you all, and hope the Lord blesses through all that has transpired over the past few months. As Paul said:
